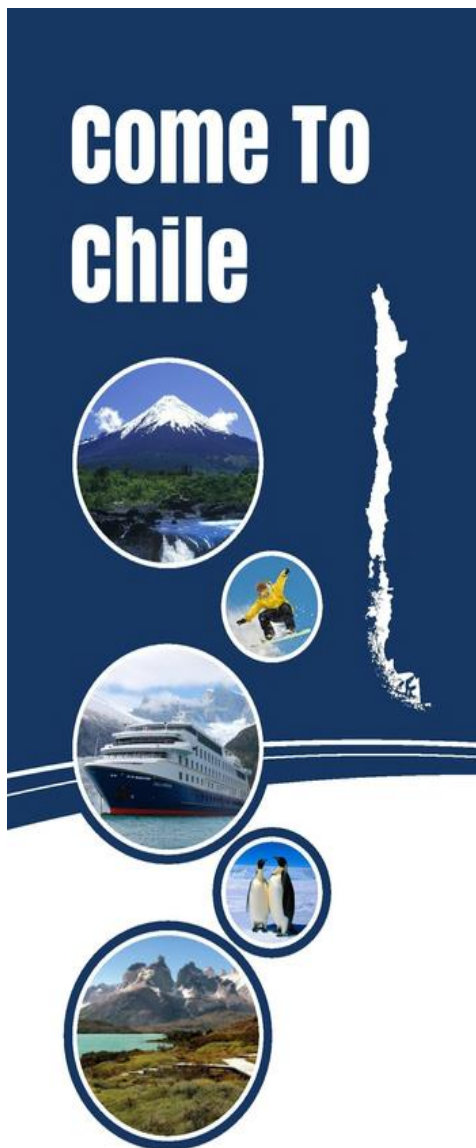

Introduction

Chile has 100 State Protected Wild Areas spread across 35 national parks, 49 reserves and 16 Monuments, covering almost 20% of the country.

The National Parks are distinguished from National Reserves and Natural Monuments because all the natural resources that exist in them can not be used for commercial purposes and must be safe.

The country also possesses ecological reserves of private initiative. All have a strong emphasis on sustainable tourism and contribute to the conservation of our ecosystems. Two of its most visited National Parks are Villarrica and the amazing Torres del Paine.

The Kingfisher, locally known as "Martin Pescador" is a beautiful bird found in the south of Chile.

It is the undisputed icon of Patagonia and is considered one of the best places for trekking. The most popular trekking trails are W (4 or 5 days) and O (8 or 9 days).

This Biosphere Reserve grasslands, forests, glaciers, mountains, lakes, rivers and a lot of wildlife.

How to get there: From Puerto Natales there are two paths: the old (going through Cerro Castillo) has 154 km (60 roads) and arrives at Laguna Amarga and Sarmiento goals, the new 80 km (via Milodon Cave), is completely gravel, which reaches the goal Serrano. In high season there are buses from Puerto Natales.
