ENGLISH GRAMMAR

WILL vs. GOING TO



WILL

Rapid Decision

- I'm thirsty. I think I **will** buy a drink.

Offer

- That looks heavy. I **will** help you with it.

Promise

- Don't worry, I **won't** tell anyone.

Threat

- If you don't stop, I **will** tell your mother.

Refusal

won't = will not

- She **won't** listen to anything I say.

GOING TO

Prior Plan

= The decision was made before the moment of speaking.

- I'm **going to** the beach next weekend with my friends.

Evidence / Signs

= When there are signs that something is likely to happen.

- My stomach hurts a lot and I think I **am going to** throw up.

- It's 70-0. They're **going to** win.

You can use both **Will** and **Going to** for making predictions.

- I think it **will** rain tomorrow. = - I think it **is going to** rain tomorrow.

COMPARE: **Are you busy this evening?**

- I haven't made any plans.

I think I **will** probably watch TV.

OR

I'm probably **going to** watch TV.

- Yes, I'm **going to** the movies.

Only **Going to** is possible because this is a prior plan.

Will and **going to** are both possible here. We are "predicting" what will happen because nothing is planned.

In spoken English **Going to** is often pronounced as "**gonna**"

Future Tense (1)

We use the **Future Tense** to talk about things that will happen **after now**.

Future Tense is easy! To use the Future Tense, you just add **will** before the verb.

***To make a *negative* Future Tense sentence, just add will not (or "won't") before the verb.**



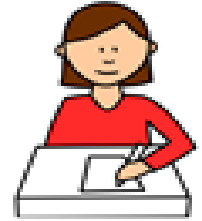
